



Verbier Festival to come to Shenzhen in 2026: First-ever edition outside Europe



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The world-renowned Verbier Festival, a hallmark of international classical music, will make its grand debut outside Europe in Shenzhen, Guangdong, China, from January 30 to February 8, 2026.

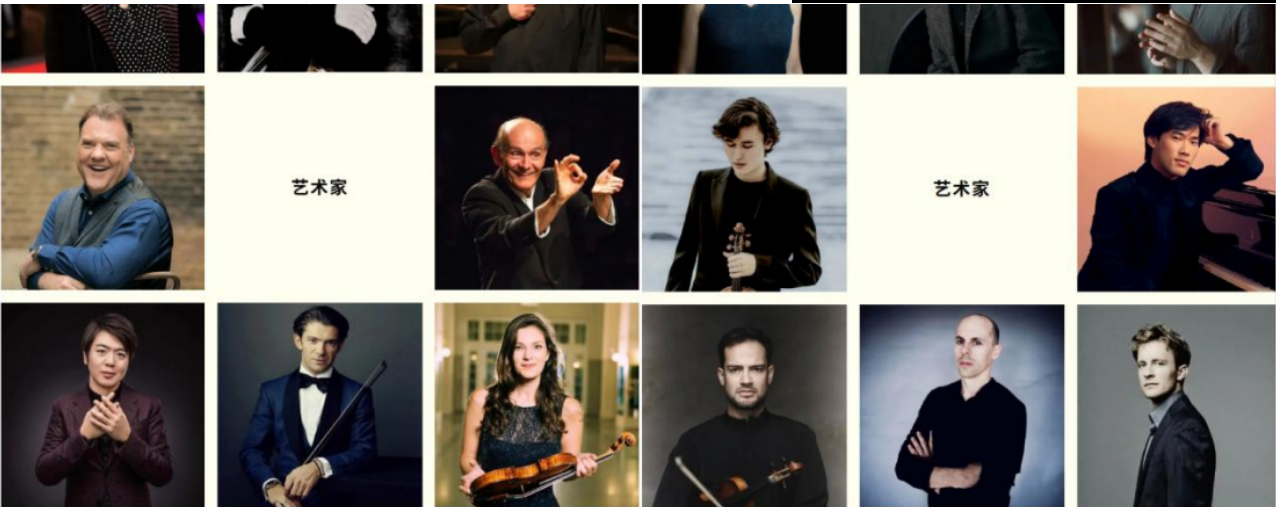

From January 30 to February 8, the festival will present 21 concerts and seven masterclasses. Highlights include symphonies, chamber concerts, and solo recitals, giving audiences the chance to witness rehearsals, attend themed music salons, and interact directly with the artists.

From Beethoven and Brahms to Piazzolla and Gershwin, the festival promises once-in-a-lifetime performances. Audiences will experience classical masterpieces alongside innovative interpretations, celebrating the shared power of music across cultures.
